

SINGLES BOX LEAGUE RULES

The Tennis Singles League is mixed gender and open to all senior playing tennis members and junior members aged 14+.

Playing Rules

(1) The league is a ladder of 'boxes' each comprising 4-5 players. A playing round lasts 5-8 weeks, during which each player should play a match against each other player in their box. All players are mutually responsible for contacting the others to arrange matches.

(2) Match Format.

Each match consists of two sets with a tie break at 6-6.

(3) Playing Times

Matches need to be played outside times set aside for social play i.e. Sat afternoons, Sun Mornings, Weds and Fri. evenings.

Promotion & Relegation

This takes place at the end of each round and is determined by a player's total games won (*not matches*). The winner and runner-up of a box are promoted upwards by **one** box. The lowest two scoring players are relegated similarly.

To request entry to the League, please email Nicky with your name (plus, for a junior, that of parent/guardian). Before each new round, we will merge each waiting player into a suitable box for their playing level
